



Macmillan Prevention and Re-enablement project

LinkAge Network is a charity which has been active in Bristol since 2007. The organisation works with people aged 50+ to create lasting solutions to reduce social isolation, improve health and wellbeing and strengthen communities. LinkAge Network achieves this mission by delivering projects, supporting the sector and running a community network for people interested in community provision for our target audience.

In 2015, LinkAge and Macmillan Cancer Support began working in partnership to support people aged 55+ living with and beyond cancer, to access a range of inspiring creative, social and physical activities. The Macmillan project has teamed up with Activity Providers across Bristol to offer people who have been affected by cancer, the opportunity to access five activity sessions for free. The project also runs regular Wellbeing events showcasing activities and services available from across the city.

The project is funded until March 2019.

The Macmillan Prevention and Re-enablement project is recruiting for a part-time Project Assistant to help in the delivery of this project. The Project Assistant will be responsible for responding to referrals; supporting the Project Manager in the coordination of Well-being events; coordinating the project evaluation process; disseminating and following up questionnaires via phone, email and post, and carrying out general administrative duties as required.
